### **Paper 02**

#### **Question 13**

This question asked candidates to discuss TWO roles that EACH of the following organisations played in the hosting of the ICC 50/50 Limited Overs World Cup 2007 in the Caribbean.

- (i) National governing body
- (ii) Regional governing body (WICB)
- (iii) International governing body (ICC)

#### Comments

For Part (i), the candidate stated that national governing bodies had the role of organising developmental matches to prepare the teams for competition. Candidate also had as a role, ensuring that players were well equipped with the necessary gear. The candidate could have spoken to the other duties more specific to 'hosting', such as selecting and organizing volunteers and assisting with transportation and parking to and from matches. Promotion and marketing strategies could also have been included.

For Part (ii), the candidate saw the WICB as being responsible for sporting facilities and advertising the event. Other more relevant duties regarding hosting the event included organizing the opening and closing ceremony, assisting in finding suitable accommodation for players, officials and even visitors. Another duty the candidate could have listed was to liaise with the ICC on the status of general preparation for the matches.

In Part (iii), the candidate mentioned that the ICC creates and enforces the rules of the event and is responsible for choosing the various countries that would host the match. Candidate could have mentioned roles that the ICC is solely responsible for, such as the anti-doping protocols at the matches and chairing the Organising Committee. Other options included being responsible for tickets and prizes, security for the players and matches, negotiating televisions and broadcasting rights and awarding contracts.

On the whole, the candidate's responses were rated as good.
